

Quilt Categories for September 2008 Quilt Show

Bed Size quilts (greater than 280" perimeter)

- *One needle - pieced, quilted, bound by one person
- *Appliqué - Uses appliqué as the predominant construction technique. May be hand or machine quilted.
- *Traditional – Predominantly pieced. May be hand or machine quilted.

Small quilts (equal to or less than 280" perimeter)

- *One needle
- *Appliqué
- *Traditional

Miniature – Any quilt that measures less than 24 inches on any side, overall patterns reflect proportionately reduced scale, and individual blocks no larger than 4 inches square. All work may be done by hand or by machine, but all work must be done by only one person.

Completely by hand – no size limit – may be done by more than one person, but must be totally completed by hand. No machines may be used.

Challenge quilt – no size limit – Must depict the theme “Quilting – a Foundation for Life”.

Art quilt – no size limit – Uses non-traditional techniques, beading, thread painting, etc. Work may be done by hand or machine.

Novice – Has less than 2 years experience and has never entered a quilt show.

Miscellaneous – Quilting used in other ways – i.e. Purses, clothing, tree skirts, etc.

There will also be a Viewer's Choice ribbon awarded.
